Your recent e-mail (below) has been forwarded to me. Whilst Ashton Parish Council has yet to comment formally, our silence should not be taken as disinterest or even acquiescence to this proposed development. To that end, I note your comment that

"Given that one of these changes relates to a road junction on the A508 in Stoke Bruerne the distribution area has been extended to include the village".

Ashton lies to the east of the A508 junction to which you refer, and it is heavily used by Ashton residents as well as an ever-increasing number of 'rat-runners'. Although it lies just in Stoke Bruerne parish, this Council has campaigned long and hard for safety improvements to the junction and it is one of, if not the major issues arising from the proposed development that concerns Ashton residents.

I would ask therefore formally request that given your decision to extend distribution of your leaflet / newsletter to Stoke Bruerne, you similarly include Ashton residents for this and all future mailings.
